

# Senator Claudia Kauffman (D)

First Native American woman to serve in the WA state Senate. She formerly served in the legislature from 2007-2011, and was recently re-elected to the position. She is the Co-Vice Chair of the Members of Color Caucus. Co-founder of the Native Action Network and works as the Intergovernmental Affairs Liaison for the Muckleshoot Indian Tribe. She is the sponsor of legislation asking state government to cover the full cost of services in their contracts with nonprofits, which CCR endorses.
